# President Obama Speaks on Immigration



President Obama called for a bipartisan effort to deal with immigration reform. In his speech

delivered on July 1 at American University he spoke of the frustration that caused states like Arizona to take matters into their own hands.

A federal suit has been brought against Arizona. In the narrow suit the government argues that "the constitution and federal law do not

permit the development of a patchwork of state and local immigration policies throughout the country."

President Obama spoke of the need for "an immigration system that's accountable." He spoke of the Statue of Liberty and its inscription. "Give me your tired and your poor, Your huddled masses yearning to be free...Send these, the homeless, tempest-tossed to me. I lift my lamp beside the golden door!"

Elected to the State Assembly in 1982, he was reelected until 2002. In 2003 he was elected to the State Senate in a special election.
